Getting to Lincoln Domain and where to park

Lincoln Domain is located at 15 Meijer Drive Halswell, Lincoln.

There will be parking at Lincoln High School on Boundary Road, which is just a short walk from the venue via a walkway.

Bus transport

There will be five pick up locations around Christchurch and the surrounding suburbs for those who have pre-purchased bus tickets.

Just remember you need to check in half an hour before the bus departs.

Sorry but, due to high demand, all the prepaid bus tickets have been sold. **BUT** there is an excellent regular Metro bus service to Lincoln on the day which runs at regular intervals from Parklands through the city centre and on to Lincoln.

Printed ezyTicket option

If you choose to print your tickets, please make sure you print the ezyTicket PDF found as an attachment to your confirmation email. There is no need to print the email itself!



If you purchased more than one ticket, you need to print each separate ezyTicket PDF as they have their own unique barcode that must be scanned for entry.

Prior to the event please ensure you fold each ezyTicket as shown on your printout for quick entry into the venue.

Camper vans & caravans
